ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

**TOWNS OF HURON AND WOLCOTT
WAYNE COUNTY, NEW YORK
WA.01 PORT BAY REDI PROJECT**

Sealed unit price bids for the construction of the **WA.01 Port Bay REDI Project** will be received by **Ron Thorn, at the office of the Wayne County Soil and Water Conservation District, 7312 Route 31, Lyons, New York, 14489** until **2:00 pm** local time on **May 20, 2026**, at which time the bids received will be **publicly** opened and read. Owner will consider bids prepared in compliance with the Instructions to Bidders and delivered as stated. Port Bay is located in the towns of Huron and Wolcott on the southern shoreline of Lake Ontario in Wayne County, NY. Significant water and wave action on Lake Ontario over the last 10 years have caused the barrier bar to breach and require continual maintenance and reinforcement by the District and Port Bay Improvement Association, notably annual to bi-annual dredging for recreational boating. This two-phased project consists of shoreline protection for the eastern and western barrier bars. Phase I serves as the base bid focused on improvements to the eastern barrier bar including stone armoring, which provides future dredge equipment access from the east, nature-based barrier bar berm with log reinforcement and gravel/cobble beach protection, bayside stabilization, turtle habitat enhancements, and plantings. Phase II serves as the add-alternative focused on improvements to the western barrier bar to include stone armoring the gap between the exiting revetment and the pier, improvements to West Port Bay Road, including a pull-off area to improve circulation to the boat launch, parking lot restoration and bayside stabilization.

Bids will be received for a single prime contract. Bids shall be on a basis of materials and equipment as indicated in the Bid Form.

Bidding documents and any addenda may be examined at no expense at Wayne County Soil & Water Conservation District, 7312 Route 31, Lyons NY 14489, phone (315) 946-7200 ext. 2 Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 9:00am to 4:00pm.

Electronic bidding documents may be obtained upon request from Wayne County Soil & Water Conservation District. The date that the bidding documents are downloaded will be considered the bidder's date of receipt of the bidding documents. Partial sets of the bidding documents will not be available from the issuing office. Neither owner nor design professional will be responsible for full or partial sets of bidding documents, including addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the issuing office.

Qualified bidder to submit bids for project as described in this document and in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Bidders must have been pre-qualified by owner prior to submission of bids. Submit qualifications of bidders as required in Section 002113 Instructions to Bidders. A performance bond, separate labor and material payment bond, and insurance in a form acceptable to owner will be required of the successful bidder. Work is subject to liquidated damages.

The successful bidder and subcontractors prior to contract award shall hold or obtain such license as required by state statutes, and federal and local laws and regulations. Bids will not be accepted from bidders that have been barred from competing on public works under General Municipal Law 5A-103-b.

Purchases made by Wayne County Soil & Water Conservation District are not subject to any federal, state, or local sales tax. Bidders shall not include in their bid sales and compensating use taxes on the cost of materials. Exemption certificates will be executed upon request.

Submit bid security with each bid in the stipulated form and in the amount identified in the Instructions to Bidders. No bids may be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after opening of bids. Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities and irregularities.

By submitting a bid, bidder represents that bidder will begin the work on receipt of the Notice to Proceed and will complete the work within the contract time indicated in the bidding documents.

A pre-bid conference for all bidders will be held at **2:00 pm local time on May 6, 2026 at Wayne County, 26 Church Street, Lyons, NY 14489**. Prospective prime bidders are requested to attend. Design professionals from Bergmann Associates (Colliers Engineering & Design) Josh Repp, PE and Hanna Quigley will provide responses at pre-bid conference to bidders' questions received up to two (2) business days prior to conference. Submit requests for clarification and interpretation using method indicated in Instructions to Bidders.
